If you're enrolled in Medicare Parts A and B, you're eligible to enroll in the Medicare Advantage plan, which lets you enhance your benefits while continuing to be an FEHB member.

## Who's eligible for our plans?

If you have both Medicare Parts A and B and live within our Medicare Advantage HMO service area, you qualify for our FEHB Medicare Advantage plans. Benefits, formulary, pharmacy network, premium and/or copayments/coinsurance may change on January 1 of each year. You must continue to pay your Medicare Part B premium. Medicare evaluates plans based on a 5-star rating system. Star Ratings are calculated each year, and may change from one year to the next.
